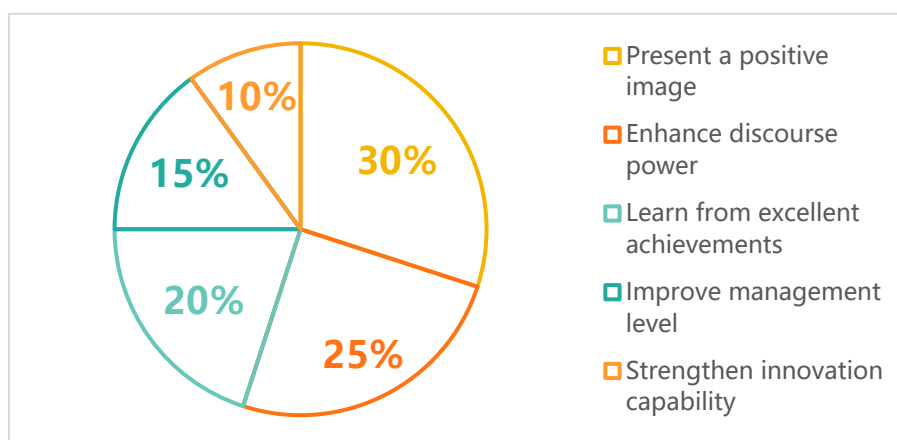


Figure 1. The Significance of Chinese Enterprises Participating in "Belt and Road" Cross-cultural Exchange and Cooperation Activities
